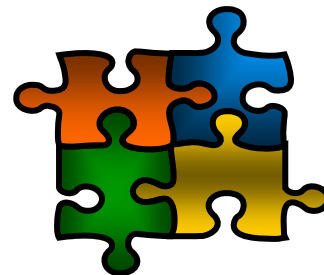


# Cross-Detection: From screening to diagnosis for youths between 15 to 30 years of age.
