Intervention at the Centre jeunesse de Montréal* for adolescent drug use and abuse

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Three levels of intervention

 SCREENING youths with alcohol and substance use problems (DEP-ADO)



 REFERRING youths with problematic substance use or addiction (red light) toward specialized addiction services by referring them to the substance abuse access mechanism for youths in Montreal (Mécanisme d'accès en toxicomanie pour les jeunes de Montréal -MATJM)



ACCOMPANYING and providing support to youths with substance use which is considered at risk for becoming problematic (yellow light) and their parents



Also ACCOMPANYING youths that have problematic consumption (red light) who are <u>little or not at all</u> motivated to receive specialized services in addiction or <u>requiring heightened structure and support</u>. An intervention in conjunction with specialized addiction services is also set in place.

Winning conditions

- A referral procedure to the MATJM and a specialized service offer in addiction were developed in collaboration with the CRDM.
- A mechanism for follow-ups grouping together all partners of the MATJM was established in partnership with the CRDM and with a clinical committee and a steering committee.
- The service offer in addiction benefits from an internal proximal support structure, namely with an addiction respondent in each team and addiction support persons.
- Training programs are offered to professionals and are available annually.

Winning conditions

- Screening intervention is integrated in the clinical process and the administration of the DEP-ADO is systematically used for all youths involved in substance use.
- The photo-toxico follow-up tool ensures that each youth receives services depending on his or her needs.
- Accompaniment tools are adapted for individual and group intervention.
- An evaluation process of the *Discussion group on drugs* program is currently being conducted with the Université de Montréal (Jean-Sébastien Fallu) and Boscoville, which will help to enhance the program.
